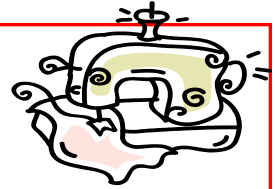
1. Fevers-Students must be fever free (without medication) for 24 hours before they can return to school.
